



New Beginnings

Domestic violence and abuse is a serious problem, it includes physical, emotional, sexual and financial abuse. New Beginnings is specifically for children who have experienced, been around or witnessed domestic abuse.

The 7-week group work programme is aimed at children aged 6 – 11 years. A maximum of 6 children may attend each programme. The sessions are run at one of our cluster schools; a different venue can be selected for each cycle dependent on availability of space etc. Please see calendar of events for more details.

The purpose of the group is to give children the opportunity to talk through any difficulties they may have experienced, identify someone they can confide in and increase their confidence and self-esteem.

The impact of the programme is measured by individual evaluations. Feedback will be presented to service requestors at the end of the programme.

Further individual support may be offered if necessary following completion of the programme.

N.B. Schools will be required to transport pupils to and from the agreed venue if they are not hosting the programme in their own setting.
