



Seacroft Manston Partnership

The Guidance and Support team has been set up to support children and families in the Seacroft Manston Cluster.

What is the Guidance and Support panel?

This panel's purpose is to discuss more complex cases and suggest services that can help. If a child/family needs extra support from the partnership, we try to find the best way to do this as quickly as possible.

A referral to the Guidance and Support panel is completed by a professional involved. This information will be taken to guidance and support panel. This panel meets regularly and discusses cases (with parents' consent). The person making the referral is expected to attend so that questions can be answered and the panel of professionals can fully understand the situation.

A co-ordinated package of support can be suggested and provided to help the family and children.

Members of the panel may include:

Adult and Child Health Services, Anti-Social Behaviour Team, Safer Schools Officer, CAMHS (Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services), Children's Centres, Children's Social Work Services, Cluster Services Team, Police, Schools, Targeted Services, Voluntary Organisations, Youth Offending Services and Youth Services.

After the meeting

The person who requested support from the panel will tell parents and young people what will happen next.
